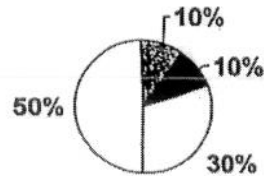

And the lives of those to come.

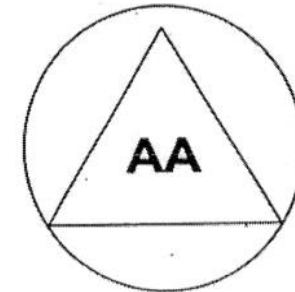

Your 7th Tradition Contribution Helps Fund the Westside Combined Districts

The Westside Districts is your home group's direct, local link to AA General Service. It sends your home group's representatives to the Area and regional service assemblies to express your opinions and gather the experiences of other groups.

Workshops and special events are produced to help your home group function effectively. Assistance is provided to groups with problems or special needs. AA speakers are referred to school and professional groups that express an interest in AA and alcoholism. Literature is distributed to the public, free of charge. Sober AA members are recruited for many types of 12th step service.

The Westside Districts cooperate with the court system and other referring agencies to promote a better understanding of AA. It provides public service announcements in various media so the hand of AA will be available to anyone with a desire to stop drinking.

The Westside Districts bring together over 14 districts representing hundreds of AA meetings Los

Angeles with thousands of AA members.

The Westside At Work

The Westside Districts need contributions from the Los Angeles groups it serves. Your group's 7th tradition contribution will ensure the future of the AA services the Westside Districts committees provide.

Westside Districts Committees

Literature: To review current literature for changes and additions and to make it available at district and other meetings. This committee educates group literature chairpeople, AA members and the general public about the tremendous assortment of AA literature and videos.

Cooperation with the Professional Community: To acquaint judges, probation officers, medical professionals and medical, dental, nursing, teaching and law schools with the AA program.

Public Information: To inform the general public about AA. Projects have included preparing survival kits for newly released residents of

hospitals and institutions and sending panels to schools and senior citizen centers. Placing Big Books in libraries, drunk tanks and participation in Red Cross and community fairs.

Treatment Facilities: To facilitate contact between experienced AA members and newcomers coming out of treatment.

The Grapevine: To make the official magazine of AA known to all meetings and available to individuals be subscription. Projects include re-distribution of past issues into hospitals and institutions.

Central Office Liaison: To foster better communication between LA Central Office and the Westside Districts.

Guidelines and Policies: To act as a resource for the interpretation and to monitor the application of the rules of order for any future changes to AA policies and suggested guidelines.

GSR Outreach: To encourage increased GSR participation in the Westside Districts and Area Assemblies to better represent the voice of AA in Los Angeles to GSO in New York.
